3. Characteristics of Academic Contribution

3.1 Academic works submitted for consideration must be works that the applicant is a first author, or an essentially intellectual contributor or a corresponding author.

The first author is the person whose title is the first author of an academic work and is responsible for producing the academic work and writing the manuscript.

The essentially intellectual contributor is the person who has made the essentially intellectual contribution to the work with a specific expertise in his or her field and is responsible for research design or academic design including data analysis, results summary and recommendations.

The corresponding author is the person who has a role and responsibility for disseminating research results or academic results and demonstrating academic value that including information presentation, research evidence presentation, opinion expression and experience expression, as well as being responsible for contacting with the editor.

3.2 If the applicant participates in the academic works, he or she must have the following characteristics:

3.2.1 In the case of research, the applicant must be the first author or

the essentially intellectual contributor or the corresponding author.

3.2.2 In the case of academic works other than research, the applicant

must be the first author or the essentially intellectual contributor.

3.3 The applicant must submit supporting documents of participation in all academic works.

3.4 An affidavit of participation in the academic work must be signed by the applicant, the first author and the corresponding author to certify the roles, duties and responsibilities of all participants that each person does in what part and how.

Once an affidavit is signed by all participants it cannot be changed.

If it is subsequently found that the degree of participation mentioned by the applicant is not consistent with the actual degree of participation, it will be deemed that such person's actions are unethical and unsuitable for academic appointment. The higher education institutions concerned must investigate the facts and proceed with disciplinary action on the applicant.

3.5 In the case of submitting community service work which operates as a group or is an integrated multidisciplinary work, the applicant must participate in at least three stages of the work process as follows:

A. Doing a situation analysis before starting community service activities.

B. Designing or developing works or ideas or activities.

C. Evaluating results and summarizing guidelines for future studies or improvement.

The applicant shall specify the roles, duties and responsibilities of all project participants as well as the main roles and duties of the applicant, endorsed by the principal investigator of each project.

3.6 In the case that the published research is the result of the student's thesis that the applicant acts as an advisor, the applicant must initiate and supervise the research as well as played an important role in analyzing and synthesizing the research results.
