Abstract

In this paper, I investigate the effect of trade liberalization on the allocative efficiency in the Thai manufacturing sector. Using the plant-level data, I show that the allocative efficiency has dropped significantly in 2011. Moreover, the degree of resource misallocation varies a lot by industry. Then, I use the change in import tariffs by industry as a proxy for trade liberalization. The results suggest that trade liberalization can improve allocative efficiencies.
